

**UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSION SPECIAL
MEETING
March 7, 2018**

The County Commission of Upshur County, West Virginia, held a special meeting at the Upshur County Administrative Annex on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. Terry Cutright called the meeting to order.
